

Trinity Road Construction Closure Information

Beginning on March 5, 2018, a portion of Trinity Road will be closed as DOT and the Department of Agriculture build a tunnel connecting the fairgrounds to Carter-Finley Stadium property. The road will reopen between August 1-September 15.

Flexibility and patience will be key to all involved during the duration of the project. PNC Arena will meet regularly with DOT, contractors, the Department of Agriculture, NC State, etc. to adjust plans for our staff and guests.

See the 3 maps below regarding the following topics.

From Edwards Mill/Trinity Road intersection, Gate B, Gate C, and Gate D will be fully accessible. From Youth Center Road, traffic may go straight to access Gate B or turn left onto Trinity to access Gate C and Gate D and Edwards Mill Road.

From Blueridge and Trinity only Gate G will be accessible. Gate A will be closed.

PNC Arena will utilize Gate G on Trinity Road to ingress and egress vehicles for events, weather pending. For early hours of ingress and for smaller events, vehicles will cross over Gate B roadway to park in Stadium East.

Staff parking in Gate C will remain normal. The biggest change will be for staff that have typically accessed Gate C via Blueridge/Trinity intersection. For those staff that have come from the Blueridge/Trinity Road intersection, you will need to either follow the detour signs and/or find a new route until the road re-opens. Staff cannot cut through PNC Arena property to access Gate C.

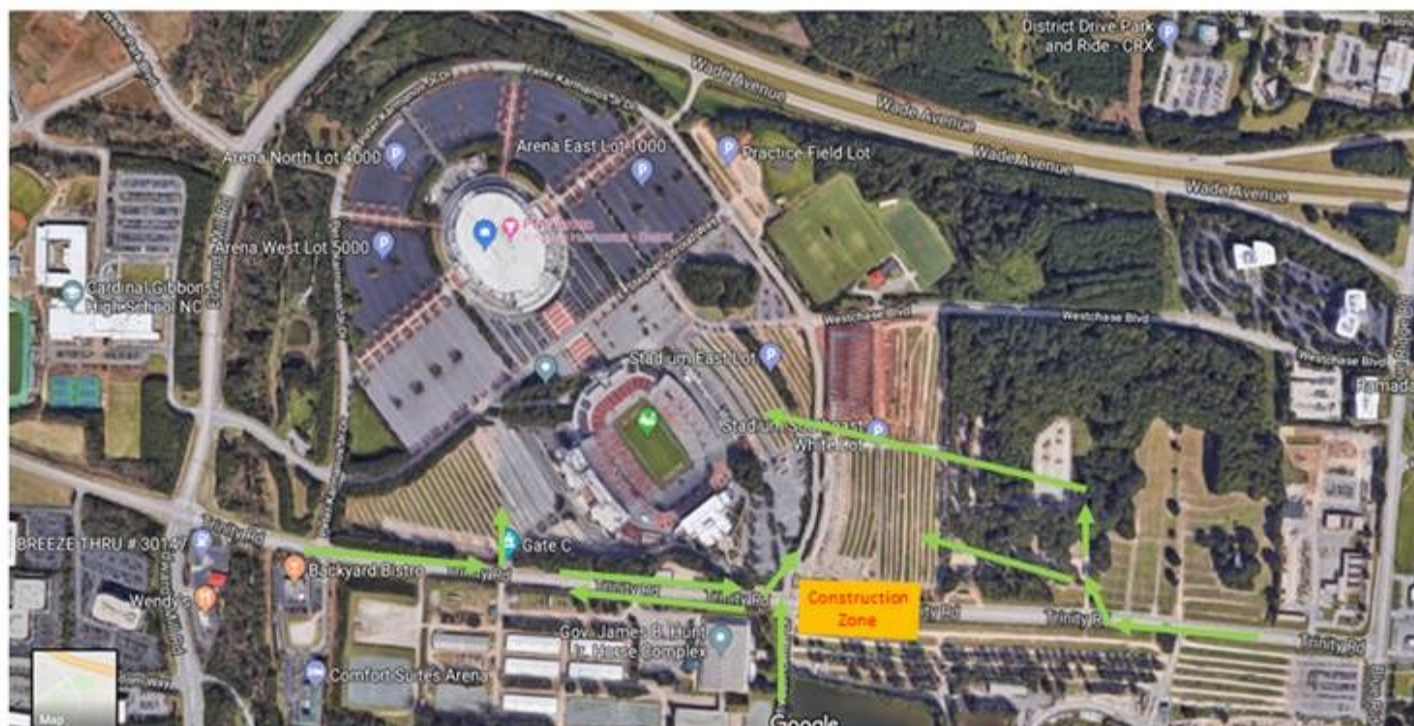
For some larger events, guest parking will be available in Gate C in order to compensate losing Gate A as an entrance coming from Edwards Mill Road.

\$10 parking for hockey games will continue; however, those guests will need to access the lot via Gate G.

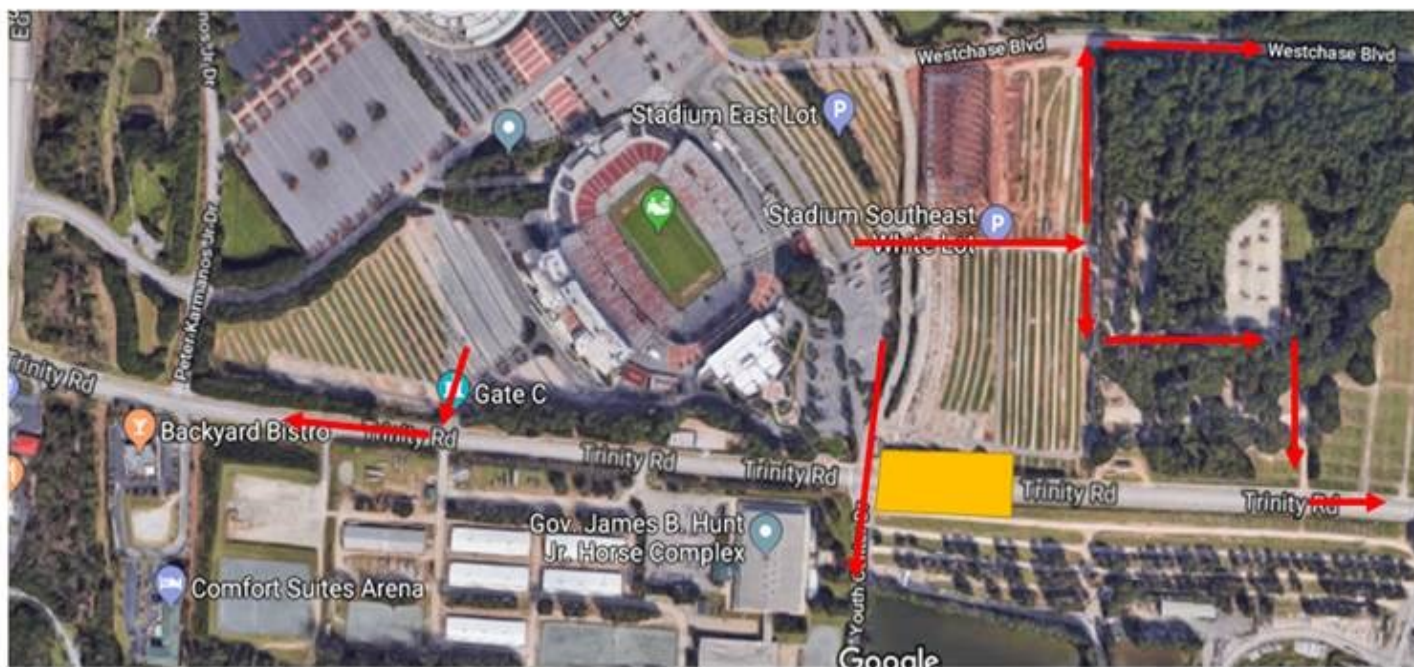
Our egress pattern will be affected greatly within Stadium East (Gate B) and Stadium Southeast (Gates A & F).

During non-event hours, there will be a barricade across VIP Roadway, between the two plazas, in an effort to eliminate cut-through traffic due to the road closure. Other, more drastic measures, will be taken by PNC Arena and/or NC State if the cut-through traffic is heavy. This will be monitored.
